
The preparation of this document was financed by a special legislative appropriation for the Department of Community and Regional Affairs, administered by the Municipal and Regional Assistance Division.



The Community Map shown here was prepared from an uncontrolled aerial photograph taken in 1983 by North Pacific Aerial Surveys for the City of McGrath that was enlarged from a scale of 1" = 2,000' to 1" = 400'. The Regional Map was prepared from the same aerial photograph as the Community Map and was reduced to 1" = .5 miles.

Property and utility information has been generalized from many sources and may contain minor inconsistencies. These maps should not be construed as surveys. On-site investigations should be conducted prior to construction.

The boundaries of the City of McGrath are as follows:  
Beginning at the NE Corner of Section 1, Unsurveyed Township UT 33N, R33W Seward Meridian, Alaska; thence west to the Northwest Corner of Section 2 UT 33N, R34W; thence south to the SW Corner of Section 35 UT 33N, R34W; thence East to the SE Corner of Section 36 UT 33N, R33W; thence to the point of beginning containing 48 square miles or less.
